At only 10 years old, Nataly had experienced incidents of angry outbursts at home and with her peers. Referred for counseling at her school, she admitted she often felt she wanted to die.


Over the course of several sessions with her CHRISTUS/ Catholic Charities school counselor, Nataly recognized triggers for negative thoughts and has been introduced to tools for positive affirmation to help replace self-destructive behaviors.

Since beginning counseling, Nataly carries herself with more confidence, has had no new incidents of self-harm, and reports regular use of coping skills like relaxation exercises and positive self-talk. Nataly will continue to work together with her counselor on her next goal of improving her self-image.



## **CHRISTUS School Clinics**

are located in 17 schools, most near CHRISTUS St. Mary's Clinic. Students receive medical care at the schools for immediate needs and those requiring physician care are connected to St. Mary's Clinic.



## **CHRISTUS Healthy Living**

Mobile Clinics bring healthcare to under-served and hard-to-reach segments of the population.

Patients – often the elderly – get health screenings and help monitoring chronic conditions such as diabetes and hypertension. Patients who need further care are referred to St. Mary's.


